


Registered Nonprofits by Type of Service, 2006

Quick Facts about Grant Parish, 2006

Compared with other parishes in Central Louisiana, Grant's nonprofit sector has the fewest revenues (\$394,000). Half of this income comes from private donations and 42 percent from government grants. There are no registered health nonprofits in Grant. Financially, about half the nonprofits that file with the IRS reported an operating deficit at the end of 2006.


